Reunions

We are set for the 2017 reunion at the Tropicana in Laughlin, Nevada. The days for that event will be different from what we have been doing. It will start on Monday, 2 October 2017 rather than Wednesday. The final day (banquet night) will be Thursday 5 October 2017 with people leaving on Friday. George D. Murphy 1948-2016

Recently we lost a most able member of the FSB Ripcord Association with the passing of George Murphy formerly of Bravo Battery 2/320 Field Artillery. George and his wife Mary were not founding members of the association having only discovered and attended their first reunion in 2004, but they were great and consistent supporters!



After Viet Nam, George got a Bachelor of Science degree and went to work for the Caterpillar Company. He found time to marry Mary Way in 1982. He was active in his community as a Cub Scout Leader, Little League coach, a member of the Newark Neighborhood Watch, a Moose Lodge member, a member of VFW Post 1486 and American Legion Post 181. George couldn't just be a member, he eventually became post commander for each of these last two organizations. When he wasn't playing golf or softball, he and Mary owned and raced harness horses in the area.

Once he discovered Keith Nolan's book on Ripcord, he became an active member of the association. When he and Mary heard that Keith had terminal cancer they took Chuck Hawkins suggestion and proceeded to check with a bank and lawyers to set up a trust fund for Anna Britt Nolan, the young daughter of Keith. By the fall of 2008 the trust fund was set and the first donations made. The success of this fund is due to the hard work and efforts of George and Mary Murphy and the others who have contributed to this wonderful cause. They felt as do most of us that without Keith Nolan's book, many of us would not know each other today or the details of the battle in which we participated.

We of the FSB Ripcord Association will greatly miss the presence and hard work of George Murphy who was and always will be a dedicated veteran, valuable member of society and a friend to all who got to know him! God speed, George, we will miss you.
