

The Beginning

After returning from Vietnam Chip Collins spent a lot of time thinking what had happened to himself and many others during the battle for FSB Ripcord in 1970. In an effort to tell what he knew of the event and find out other information he decided to publish a newsletter in 1985. It was a small, irregularly published beginning but it allowed Ripcord Veterans an opportunity to relate their experiences during the siege. He soon heard from others and the newsletter and the Ripcord Association grew from that very minor beginning.

The Newsletter

John Mihalko and Ray Blackman were among the first to be contributors of retrospectives of their Ripcord experiences. (The first Ripcord Report published can be read on our website.) As years went by, Bill Heath had published an anniversary newsletter, Ray Blackman took over editorship quickly followed by Chuck Hawkins in the end of 1989. He continued on as editor for many years with Patti Radford doing the distribution. In 2003 Frank Marshall took over the task as the Editor with assistance from Lee Widjeskog, Patti Radford and Dennis Bloomingdale.

The Ripcord Report Newsletter is for all Ripcord Survivors, Families and Friends. Your help is needed to keep the newsletter informative by sending us the information and your donations pay for the printing and postage.

Membership

We now have 487 members in the Association. There are 354 on the mailing list and 133 receive the newsletter electronically thru e-mail. There are 328 Ripcord Veterans. The others are family, associate members and status unknown. We know this is not a "final" list. Please help us continue to revise/update our Association roster.

Website

In the last few years, the Ripcord Association with the efforts of Frank Marshall has established a website at www.ripcordassociation.com.

Since the last revision the website has had 6200 visits and before the revision had over 2,000 visits. That means our website has had over 8000 visits since it was started. It is a good place to get additional information about the Association, our Reunions, the history of FSB Ripcord, it's members, many more stories, biographies, photos and a lot of updated and important information about the Ripcord Association.

Surveys (Important)

Every so often we conduct surveys of the membership with postcards and / or the website. These surveys are important keeping an updated roll call for the membership and in helping us understand where the membership wants to hold the reunions.

Reunions

Reunions were an off-spring of the newsletter. In 1986 John Mihalko, Chip Collins, Chuck Hawkins and Frank Marshall sat in John's living room and planned the first Ripcord Reunion. John hosted the first official Ripcord Association Reunion with the help of VFW Post 5351 in Whippany, New Jersey. Thirteen veterans from the Ripcord Battle, along with various wives and girl friends, attended. The veterans included Ray Blackman, Fred Behrens, Rick Blyth, Dick Cable, Chip Collins, Jim Fairhall, Chuck Hawkins, Bill Heath, Frank Marshall, John Mihalko, John Sherba, Tom Sheppard and George Westervelt

Chuck Hawkins and John Mihalko hosted the next few reunions at Washington, Golden and Fredericksburg. Then Fred Spaulding took over and put together reunions at Mobile, Atlantic City and Savanna. Jim Campbell put the Shreveport reunion together and Fred continued with Carlisle, Colorado Springs, Charleston, Des Moines and Indianapolis this year. Now Fred is stepping down after the 2005 and someone else is going to have to step up and take over the reunions. This will not be an easy task.

Future Reunions

Some future reunions have already been scheduled. For 2006 Fred has set up a good price back in Charleston SC. However, we need someone to come forward and handle the ground work before we arrive and direct things during the event. This is not a terribly hard job, but is best done by someone in the general area with a little bit of time. Fred will help you through the issues but the person must take the lead for the event. This will be the way the reunions will be handled in the future. Each place will be handled by someone nearby rather than have to make one person run all over the country. If anyone has a good suggestion for the 2006 reunion that might better serve our Association than a return to Charleston, please let us know and we will assess any financial penalty that we might incur by changing the location.

For 2007 Branson, MO has been selected under the direction of Mike and Liz Womack.

Frank Marshall put out a survey to see if the membership would like to have the reunion in 2008 on a Cruise Ship. The response has been very positive. I have to do more checking into it to make sure it would be practical for everyone to attend. I will keep you posted on the website and at the reunion meeting.

Reunion Locations

There has been quite a flurry of activity recently on where and when the reunions should be held. Members have to realize that it is not easy to please everyone all the time. That is what the survey is for. The person that takes over setting up the reunions is volunteering their time. We must consider that not all persons wish to attend a reunion and some cannot afford to spend a lot of time and money away from home for the events. All locations will ultimately be a compromise on cost, location and timing to satisfy the majority of attendees.
