


Ripcord Association 2024 Myrtle Beach, SC Reunion

The FSB Ripcord Association held its first reunion in 1986 in Whippany, NJ hosted by Chip Collins and John Mihalko. In 1987, Chuck Hawkins put together another reunion on the edge of Washington, DC. Then none were held until 1995, when John Mihalko organized one in Golden, Colorado. Since then, the annual reunions were set up by Fred Spaulding with the exception of the 2000 reunion in Shreveport, LA which was honchoed by Jim Campbell. Lee and Kathy Widjeskog started taking charge of planning and organizing the reunions in 2010. John Fowler did all the preparations and contact with the hotel to make sure all went well.



Coin Presentation



After attending the 1995 reunion, General Harrison decided the survivors of the Ripcord Battle deserved a little more recognition for surviving the battle and finding the courage to meet with others who suffered during and after the battle. He developed a design and had a two-sided coin created. The coin shows the firebase and surrounding hills 805, 902 and 1000 which were pivotal to the outcome of the battle. The reverse side has the 101st shield and sentiments. Each year since 1997, a coin has been presented to survivors who are attending their first reunion. In cases where family members of those killed in the battle attend, coins are presented to the family in memory of the departed. The recipient is called upon the stage and cheered by his battle peers as the coin is presented. The pictures that follow, show the most recent recipients.


